How can I earn Honors credit for my 10th grade English class?

Option A

Receive a college-ready qualification score from Cambridge.

Steps

- 1. Thoroughly read all assigned literature
- 2. Participate in class discussions and complete class assignments
- 3. Practice timed writing assessments
- 4. Complete two coursework essays
- 5. Study for Cambridge exam
- 6. Take the Cambridge exam
- 7. Wait until August 2019 to find out

Option B

Submit 4 original pieces of writing to accredited contests and/or publishers Steps

- 1. Let your teacher know that you will be choosing this option and receive Honors Plan Proposal
- 2. Examine list of approved contests to select and fill in your Honors Plan Proposal
- 3. Submit your Honors Plan Proposal by August 31st, 2018
- 4. Write one entry per quarter: You must do 4 different types of writing
 - a. Poem(s)
 - b. Short Story
 - c. Essay
 - d. Opinion Editorial
- 5. Conference with your teacher BEFORE turning in work each quarter
- 6. Turn in work by deadline and take screenshot or save email that you submitted
- 7. Collect each piece of writing in a portfolio that includes:
 - a. Your piece of writing
 - b. Writing contest guidelines for submissions
 - c. Proof of your completed submission (screenshot, email, etc.)
 - d. Reflection of what you have learned about your writing from this process
- 8. Submit your portfolio by May 3rd, 2019
- 9. Work will be reviewed
- 10. Present your reflection using a powerpoint, poster, or other format
- 11. Receive notification that you have earned Honors credit by end of school year
